CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE APPOINTMENT TO THE LEGAL AND ADVERTISEMENT COMMITTEE (ToR) JUNE 2026

BACKGROUND

The Namibia Medicines Regulatory Council hereby invites suitably qualified and experienced professionals to apply for appointment to serve on the **Legal and Advertisement Committee (LAC)** established in terms of Section 13 of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 2003 (Act No. 13 of 2003).

PURPOSE OF THE COMMITTEE

The Legal and Advertisement Committee serves as an expert advisory body to Council on matters relating to the legal interpretation and application of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, the advertisement and promotion of medicines and related substances, import and export permits and licensing matters as well as regulatory compliance and enforcement matters and the review of agreements, contracts, and legal instruments affecting NMRC.

REQUIRED EXPERTISE

Applications are invited from suitably qualified individuals with professional experience in one or more of the following fields: Law and Legal Practice, Police/Drug and Law Enforcement Services, customs and Excise Enforcement, and be Pharmacy and Licensing experts in terms Health professions Council Veterinary Medicine and Veterinary Public Health

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should possess a relevant recognized qualification in the applicable field with at least five (5) years' relevant professional experience. Must have knowledge of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 2003 and have good ethical standing and high professional integrity;

TERM OF APPOINTMENT

Members shall be appointed by Council in accordance with Section 13 of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 2003, and shall serve for a period of three (3) years.

Committee members who are not employed full-time by the State may receive remuneration and allowances as determined in terms of Section 10 of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 2003.
